Morning 9am: Meet on the rear Capitol Steps and we'll start wandering around the Capitol Park photographing the various gardens, monuments, areas and even the squirrels!

Noon: Lunch will be from **12pm to 1pm**. There are plenty of places to eat nearby.

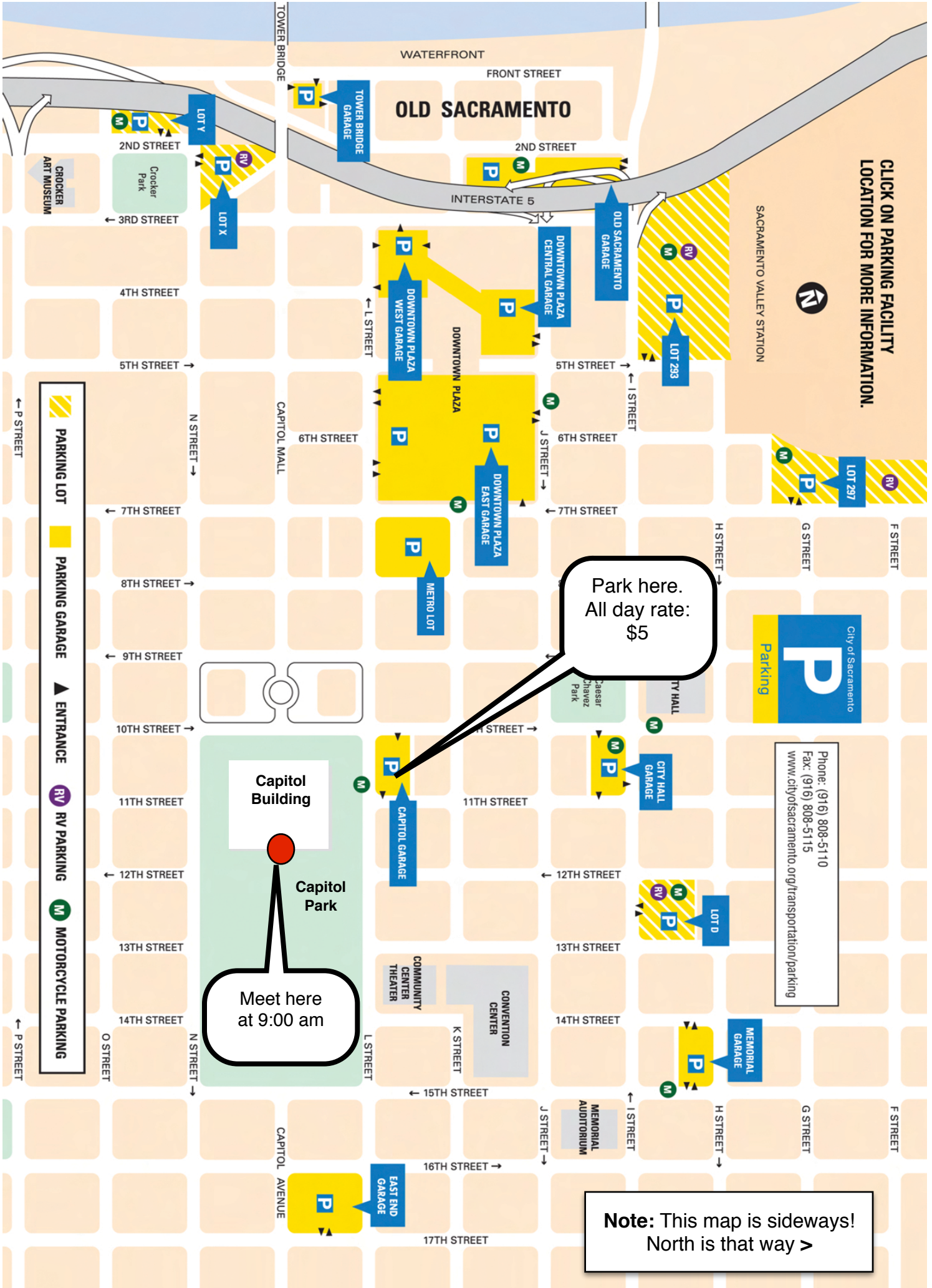
